SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

School Dress Code

Students are expected to wear their school uniform every day. Students are required to wear the appropriate school uniform or dress requirements whenever they participate in activities outside the school. Students and/or parents/carers will be informed when temporary changes, eg mufti days, are allowed.

Students in Y3 – Y6 classes have sports uniform which is worn on their prescribed sport day or when requested.

- Using these guidelines, all teachers have the authority to direct students to remove unsuitable and/or unsafe apparel. Our guideline is that for competitive sport e.g netball, football etc. with the exception of stud (for boys only) or a sleeper ear ring, one necklace hidden beneath the top/shirt and a medical alert or plain bracelet. On special occasions a silicon bracelet may be worn which identifies the cause for the bracelet. Some children may elect to wear a plain ring however during sport the children will be directed to remove items that may cause injury.
- Safety considerations under WH & S and the NSW Department of Education and Training Sunsafe Policy requires students to wear the broad brimmed school hats as directed. At Grafton Public School, there is a 'No Hat, Play in the Shade' policy in place. All teachers have the authority to direct students to comply with this policy. (Only shade provided by the COLAS)
- Students attending school out of uniform will be exchanged alternative clothing to wear for the day.
- **Students representing the school are required to wear the appropriate uniform including the school hat for the event.**
- We understand that at times, there may be difficulties in providing a uniform. If this situation occurs, we would appreciate a note addressed to the classroom teacher.
